

12th Sunday in Ordinary Time – 2024 – Hook

Storms. Many moons ago when I was just seventeen, I was press ganged into crewing for one of the tall ships. The ship was an 88-foot ketch called the Rona. It was 2am one mid-February when we were caught off Jersey in a Force 8 gale. I was selected to keep watch off the bow end, which involved being strapped to the railings, to keep an eye for passing vessels across the busiest shipping lane in the world. In the midst of the nightmare conditions, I woke up to the loudest noise. Then a light, seemingly as bright as the sun, appeared above us. As plain as day I came face to face with a wall of red completely filling my horizon. In the middle of the red was a white strip extending upwards. It was the first letter of Townsend Thoreson. We had almost collided with the hugest of ships, which I just didn't see.

Storms, in all their forms, cultivate fear. Fear disorientates. It prevents us from seeing the truth, the wood for the trees. Fear makes us lose perspective. Fear counters faith. In their fear

'the disciples woke him..., "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?"'

Despite their panic – 'Sea of Galilee' squalls are notoriously ferocious – the disciples knew where to find calm. They chose to place their trust in the Lord over and above their fear.

This is surely the lesson for us today. When storms come our way Brothers and Sisters; when we are bereft, bereaved, beaten down, disorientated, powerless; the Lord invites us to turn to Him, precisely then. Even, and especially, when the storm is self-inflicted, when we've made mistakes, perhaps large ones, even then God can and will turn it around if we choose to trust Him.

Storms need not lead to hopelessness. In the light of faith, they can lead us to hope, and to an even greater awareness of God's faithfulness. Trust Him in, and above, all things.
