Conference Pears. I went to a local store during the week and bought four bigguns. They looked fabulous on the outside. Felt firm. All good I thought. Brought them home. Sat down and took a bite. It was like biting into paper. It was dry, tasteless, lifeless. I felt hugely disappointed, let down, defrauded even. It just wasn't the pear it looked like on the outside. Jesus used the well-rehearsed words of the Prophet Isaiah to describe some of the Pharisees, the leading religious men of

"These people honour me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me."

On the outside they resembled Conference Pears, Godly souls. They kept all the rules and regs that governed external Judaism, but once bitten into, on the inside, it was another story. Their hearts were far from God.

"They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human rules.' You have let go of the commands of God ...holding on to human traditions."

Brothers and Sisters, it is possible to be externally compliant with all sorts of religious regulations and yet be spiritually dead. We have heard Jesus many times these past weeks, calling us to life, not existence. He expects us to allow His life, His Grace, into ours, for our hearts to be close to His.

How can it be that Catholic Church leaders across the world take up five collections throughout the year for the Vatican without hesitation, when they know there is substantial reason to believe there is serious criminality going on? How can basic morality have been replaced by corporate loyalty? The commands of God let go. Hearts evidently far from God. How can it be that a woman faithfully serving God's people for decades in parish work, going the extra ten miles with her faith, compassion, love and service, could be told not to go to Holy Communion because of a divorce a lifetime ago? Her heart is close to God, evidently, but where is the heart of the 'church'?

Where is your heart? We can only follow Jesus with our hearts, the core of our being, where our deepest desires are known. Don't move the goalpost. Love God. Love neighbour. Love and respect yourself. Mark 7:1-23
