FINANCIAL INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

The Parish had a loss of Income over Expenditure in 2023/24 of £15,129.41.

Repairs and Maintenance included the annual maintenance such as Fire Extinguishers, PAT testing, monthly grounds maintenance, window cleaning and Gas Safe certificates. Repairs to the heating in both the Church and the Priest's House, we renewed the heaters in the hall. An asbestos survey was carried out and we had to have 3 ceilings and the water tank removed from the Priest's House. In October 2023 we found that Mr Squirrel had chewed all the leading from the hall roof and water was dripping in, this added to the expenditure for the year.

Greatness. If I am being completely honest, I have suffered with the common malaise that is ambition, the desire to see myself promoted. In unguarded moments I have wondered how I would respond if I received a call from Wimbledon, the Papal Embassy, to be offered a Monsignor-ship? It would be a tough call. I hope my response would be a gracious decline. It would be a disaster for my soul if I were to accept such preferment. I know it would dramatically hinder my attempt to live the Christian life, never mind ministry.

I know this to be true because of the teaching Jesus offers us today. A dispute had broken out among these apprentice bishops as to which of them was the greatest. This same debate sadly continues among Christian hierarchs today! Having been overheard they became silent.

Using the by now familiar preaching technique – showing, not telling – Jesus responded. He took a "..child in His arms, and He said, whoever welcomes one of these little children in my name, welcomes me."

Alongside other dependant human beings, Jesus teaches us that children are an indispensable source of Grace for us. When we serve others, wholeheartedly, we come into contact with Jesus Christ Himself, who came to serve and not to be served.

Greatness is found in heart and soul servanthood.

Two lessons. First, every Christian is called to service. This is what happens when Grace flows in our bloodstream. No matter what status in life, a Christian serves, by definition. Second, the place of children. Children must be part of our scene. Can a truly Christian community exist without children? Their presence surely reminds us of our responsibility to be in service mode, constantly. Just as children's health and well-being are prospered when adults take responsibility for their needs. So, our brothers and sisters yet to hear the Good News will be prospered when we reveal Christ in our service. Thus, when we put ourselves out, when we take the last place, we become great.
