# FINANCIAL INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

The Parish had a loss of Income over Expenditure in 2023/24 of £15,129.41.

Repairs and Maintenance included the annual maintenance such as Fire Extinguishers, PAT testing, monthly grounds maintenance, window cleaning and Gas Safe certificates. Repairs to the heating in both the Church and the Priest's House, we renewed the heaters in the hall. An asbestos survey was carried out and we had to have 3 ceilings and the water tank removed from the Priest's House. In October 2023 we found that Mr Squirrel had chewed all the leading from the hall roof and water was dripping in, this added to the expenditure for the year.

# Fr Kevin Delaney RIP—Vigil Mass—3rd October 2024

I first met Fr Kevin thirty years ago. I had not long been ordained. I think he used to supply in Abingdon when I was stationed there. I remember him telling me off on more than one occasion. I can't remember what it was about. I probably deserved it. Kevin came across to me as a bit of a stickler for the rules. I readily saw him as a faithful son of the church, doing and saying whatever was commanded of us. He instructed me to do the same!

We lost touch over the years until my arrival here at Sacred Heart eighteen months ago. Kevin had changed a bit. It was a delight to witness Kevin more obviously bearing the image of the Good Shepherd, continuously reaching out to God's people, even from his bed! I know many of us went to Confession with Fr Kevin, or simply to receive God's blessing through him. In the words of Jeremiah,

".. The Lord reached out his hand and touched my mouth and said to me, "I have put my words in your mouth."

This happened through Fr Kevin's ministry. We heard God speak. Today we give thanks that Kevin became more that the church's son. He became a faithful son of God. By Grace he imaged Jesus, and it is by God's Grace we continue to receive God's mercy.

Thus, the Psalmist reminds us to always give thanks to God for his mercy. Everyone of us is dependent upon it, after all. Authentic Christians will always carry the hallmark of mercy. We pass on what we ourselves have received, as St Paul has it. That's the deal. So, we pray that Kevin is best placed to receive the mercy that comes to us by faith, to trust the Lord in and above all things. May he Rest in Peace and rise in glory. Amen.
