32nd Sunday of the Year - Year B - 2024

Making an impression. During the week I was flattered. I went for a blood test. I put my arm out. The nurse said, "John, you really are a handsome man." "Really?", I said bashfully. "No," she said. "I Just wanted to distract you from the scratch!"

It was another occasion of flattery I really wanted to mention. I was asked to speak at a government policy thinktank on the 28th of this month regarding the plight of Travellers in society. Fame at last! My diary revealed four clashes, so I started to work out which of the commitments could be postponed. I was stopped in my tracks, probably by the Holy Spirit. Why was I even thinking of cancelling Bishop Challoner School youngsters, the blessing of a grave on a first anniversary; two of the obligations listed for the 28th? Why were these once considered top priorities now being displaced? My motivation had been compromised.

Beneath the rather obvious themes of showing off and ostentatious generosity in the Gospel today, the Lord wants us to look at our motivation for doing things. It's not so much about what we do, but the way we do it, and why. The lawyers get it in the neck again as many were seeking status and standing in the public eye, at others cost. Look at me! Their lives pointed to themselves. On the evidence they appeared to attach more importance to themselves than anyone else, the polar opposite to humility. A similar story, perhaps, with at least some of the rich folk in the Temple, putting wads of cash in the collection. Look at me!

So, Jesus draws our attention to the Widow. This woman of very little means. She gave of what she had, not what she had over. Her meagre budget destined for essentials was also, in her mind and heart, to be shared. No aspect of her life was ringfenced for herself. Thus, this mighty woman – the Widow's Might - was the greatest of all the personalities in the mix. Thus, she continues to impress us 2000 years on.

Where does your life point? Where do you invest? Remember last week's Gospel. The greatest impression is love.
