You will have gathered that I am not well at the moment. I write awaiting biopsies in relation to a number of tumours located in four sites in my neck/head that were discovered just over a week ago. Hopefully not cancer. In any event, it now seems likely that I will face surgery, in the hope further deterioration may be halted. You will be kept posted, via updates in the newsletter, but not by me personally. My mobile phone/email etc is being 'looked after' for the moment, just to make you aware. My sisters, and colleagues, are taking it in turns to stay with me during this period. So I'm being utterly spoiled, truth be told.

A person of faith, I am re-learning, is one who first learns to receive. God's Grace always precedes any decision we think we make to receive it, in order to follow the Lord. The current experience is taking me back to basics, rather dramatically, reminding me how to receive again. Thus, I am grateful, so grateful, to you all for your prayers, good wishes and love. SECOND COLLECTIONS: SECOND COLLECTION FOR ST JOHN'S CATHEDRAL—SUNDAY 26TH JANUARY 2025

The annual Second Collection for St John's Cathedral, Mother Church of the Diocese, will take place on Sunday 26th January.

Canon James McAuley, Dean of the Cathedral, writes:

Since I became Dean of our Cathedral Church of St John the Evangelist in September 2022, the parish has had to pay for the emergency repair of three serious roof leaks, as well as the replacement of two failing flat roofs. The cost of these repairs was met from parish funds. In 2023, the 120-year-old West Window had to be shored up, removed and completely restored to prevent its imminent collapse. So far, generous donors from the parish and from across the diocese have contributed £84,130 of the £90,100 cost of repair.

Our most recent quinquennial architectural survey (autumn 2023) indicated work required over the next few years to the roof, windows, heating, and electrical systems at an estimated cost of £2 million plus VAT.

ĭfully appreciate the financial pressures being felt by you and by your parishioners but would appeal to you to promote and support the Second Collection for the Cathedral on 26th January. Never has this annual collection by parishes for the Mother Church of the Diocese been more critical or needed. Your support is vitally important to us.


