Hopefully not cancer. In any event, it now seems likely that I will face surgery, in the hope further deterioration may be halted. You will be kept posted, if not by me personally. My mobile phone/email etc is being 'looked after' for the moment, just to make you aware. My sisters, and colleagues, are taking it in turns to stay with me during this period. So I'm being utterly spoiled, truth be told.

A person of faith, I am re-learning, is one who first learns to receive. God's Grace always precedes any decision we think we make to receive it, in order to follow the Lord. The current experience is taking me back to basics, rather dramatically, reminding me how to receive again. Thus, I am grateful, so grateful, to you all for your prayers, good wishes and love. RITE OF ELECTION

This year's Rite Of Election takes place on Saturday 8th March at 11am in St John's Cathedral, Portsmouth. The Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion takes place each year on the Saturday after Ash Wednesday. It is the liturgy in which those adults who are preparing for Baptism at Easter and those candidates who are preparing to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church are presented to the Bishop for the Church's blessing. For the 'catechumens' (those under catechesis for Baptism) especially, this Rite is important: it's the moment in their formation when they are formally 'elected' or chosen by the Bishop, on the testimony of their godparents and others, to become members of the Church. Their names are inscribed in the Book of the Elect to signify that they have heard the Lord calling them by name and that they wish to respond publicly to His call. The Rite of Election is always full of joy! Since the mission of our Diocese of Portsmouth is Bringing People Closer to Jesus Christ through His Church and as a sign that mission and evangelisation is always our first priority, Bishop Philip invites everyone in the Diocese to come and join us for the celebration. Please pray for the catechumens and candidates, together with their sponsors, families and friends.
