Second Sunday of Lent - Year C - 2013

Faces. I was having a chat with a woman who told me that it took two hours to 'put her face on'. Her face mattered that much. During my most recent consultation with the docs regarding my surgery, I was told part of my face would be 'peeled back' to remove the lump. I too have decided that my face matters! It just might be the end of my modelling career though!!

Our faces do matter. They contain our eyes, windows into the soul. They contain our mouths through which we communicate what is in our hearts, revealing what really concerns us deep down.

"As He – Jesus - was praying, the appearance of His face changed, and His clothes became as bright as a flash of lightning."

The face of Jesus changed when He prayed. When we spend time with God, our faces will change because our hearts, where our desires live, will have changed first. Others will notice us becoming more like Jesus. They will recognise God living in us, which is what defines Grace.

There's a lot of talk about evangelisation, sharing the Good News that God so loved the world that He sent us His son. Too much talk! Evangelisation happens when God does the work, in and through our hearts, in and through our minds, in and through our bodies. It will be written all over our faces! God's work will be seen in us.

In a sense, Lent is about 'putting our faces on' J. When we pray, we allow God access into our hearts. Spending time with God is indispensable, but it's not about quantity. It's about quality, however short a time. Saying hello to God at the beginning of the day, thanking Him at the end of it, in the car, wherever it may be. Above all, prayer is a time to hear God speak.

"A voice came from the cloud, saying, "This is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to him.""

Brothers and Sisters, **Prayer principally concerns listening**, especially to God's Word. Next week, you will receive a copy of Luke's Gospel for you to take away so you can listen to Him.
